Arrangements for Parents from the Hackney Music Service

SEATING: Seating is allocated on a first come, first served basis. Seats cannot be reserved in advance so we recommended that you arrive in plenty of time to secure a seat. Audience seating is in the upper gallery only, which accommodates 450 people. Once the venue is full, no further access will be permitted. We hire the hall on the understanding that we do not exceed the stated capacity and do not breach Health and Safety requirements. Please be aware that you will not be allowed in to the venue whilst schools are still in rehearsal.

PROGRAMME: The planned programme may overrun slightly, so please plan for this possibility. Once the performance is finished, parents & carers may go in to the performance hall to collect their children. Please check with your school that this is the arrangement they have made, as some schools prefer to escort children back to their school.

COLLECTION OF CHILDREN: When collecting your child, please bear in mind that finishing times may vary from the advertised times and there may be a short wait. We do all we can to stick to the schedule, but sometimes performances overrun slightly. We ask for your cooperation and patience if this happens.

We strongly urge parents to allow their children to finish the performance, however if there are unavoidable circumstances where a child is required before the end of a performance, please see one of the stewards who will assist you.
