Subject: Outbreak Management Plan

Dear parents and carers,

Please find attached, the Gayhurst Outbreak Management Plan.

We are at the threshold number of cases in Year 5/6 so we will now follow Tier 2 adaptations to hopefully reduce transmission.

It is essential that parents and carers of children in 5/6 are familiar with the new restrictions in place from Monday morning – as advised by Public Health England.

We will review the Tier 2 measures in 5/6 on Friday 24th September.

The rest of the school will continue with current arrangements in Tier 1.

For ease of reading:

Actions for children in 5/6 from Monday 13th September

- Review and reinforce testing, hygiene and ventilation measures in place:
(In addition to Tier 1)
 - Strengthened communications: encourage testing of children
 - Increased testing: affected staff testing using LFDs daily; staff who are close contacts carry out PCR in addition to LFDs
 - Siblings of positive cases isolate at home for full 10-day period
 - Re-introduction of bubbles inside of the school building in affected area
 - The wearing of masks by staff in communal areas are encouraged in affected area
 - Re-introduction of online assemblies in affected area
 - Re-introduction of separate eating in the lunch hall for affected area
 - Staff meetings on Teams for affected areas
 - Limit educational visits for affected area
 - Live performances cancelled for affected area
 - Parents in affected area not to enter school building
 - Wraparound (Breakfast Club and Extended Day) care restricted for affected area
 - Children in affected area line up outside at the start of the day and are collected by teachers and taken to classroom separately
