EXTENDED DAY PROVISION

At Gayhurst, we offer an extended day provision to support families who may be unable to collect at 3:30pm. This provision is run by members of staff who work until 5:45 to deliver this service, this is an optional service that school provides to help support our community and families. It is important that parents/carers collect their children on time from extended day to allow for our staff members to leave work on time and continue with their own commitments and childcare arrangements. We will now be charging parents £1 a minute for late collections after 4:45pm, if your child is booked into short extended day and for long extended day after 5:45pm.
