#### **2L VISIT HACKNEY MUSEUM**

This term Year 2 have been studying the topic 'Hackney in the past' in their History lessons. We have looked at Hackney in the late Victorian period and thought about what has stayed the same and what has changed in terms of transport, fashion, architecture and jobs. We also found out about two memorable figures from Hackney's past: the nurse Edith Cavell and the footballer-turned-officer Walter Tull, both of whom died in World War 1. This week it was 2L's turn to visit Hackney Museum to bring our learning to life. We had so much fun exploring this interactive gallery that spans the ages. We travelled back over 1000 years ago to row an Anglo-Saxon boat, we dressed up as Victorian children, we served up some delicious dinner at the Eel Pie shop (!), got our hair done at the barbers and, of course, boarded the 38! We also looked at a photography exhibition which featured an amazing shot by Neil Martinson of Gayhurst's very own Sharen Woodward! 2L loved the art installation of the block of flats, featuring miniature families and homes to peek into. We thoroughly recommend a visit to Hackney Museum - it is open from Tuesdays to Saturdays and entrance is free!
