LEAP SCHOOL COUNCILS

On Monday the School Councillors from Gayhurst, Kingsmead and Mandeville met to discuss an exciting joint project. The children met with Jessie Mond Wedd, a legal consultant for Lawyers for Nature. They found out about the 'We are Nature' project which wants to change the dictionary definition of 'Nature' to include humans.

The school council listened to why this was important, how humans are connected to nature, how we can protect it more and how we can get involved.

The school councillors plan to deliver an assembly in their LEAP school, following a discussion with the Headteacher. They will be asking the children across LEAP, 'How do you define nature?' Children are able to respond to the question in the form of a drawing, a poster, a story, a poem, or by writing their own definition.

own translation of the Columbian story 'Eloisa y los Bichos'. We loved the story and highly recommend it to Spanish learners to improve their reading skills!


The children demonstrated outstanding communication and teamwork skills and made us all very proud. ¡Un trabajo bien hecho!
