Each week we develop key techniques and skills that we apply to final pieces. Take a look at just some of the amazing artworks we have produced so far this year!


































#### ART AT LEAP CONTINUED......

Next term we will be looking at Surrealism and Contemporary Art, so watch this space!








## **SPECIAL HOLIDAY FREE** FOOD SHOP


